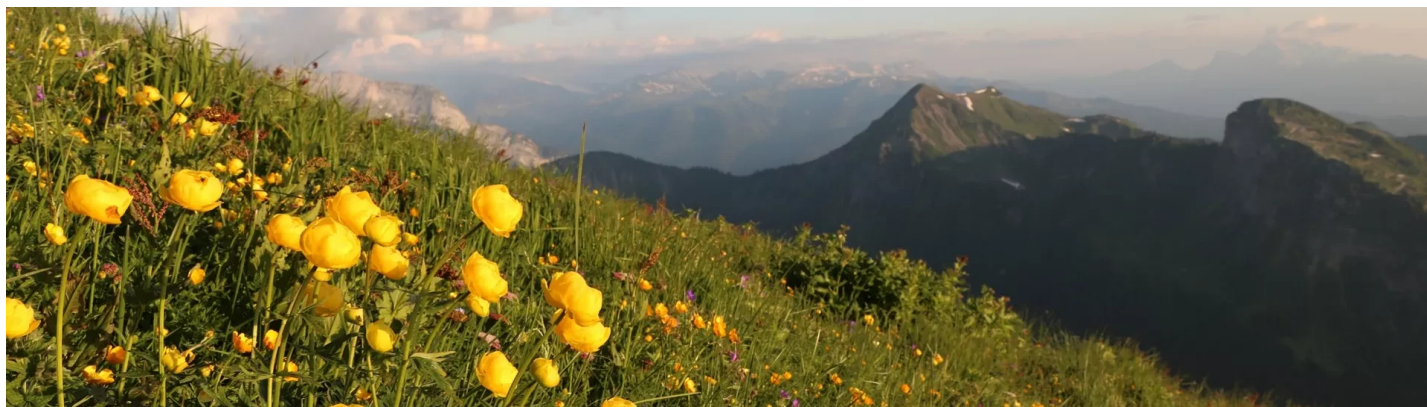


MORZINE PANORAMA

Morzine is well known for its ski resort but is also part of a wider mountain range at the limits of Mont Blanc massif. The label "Géopark", awarded by Unesco in 2012, recognises the treasures of this area: wildlife, geology, history, human heritage, gastronomy, flora...

We'll discover some surprising landscapes during beautiful easy hikes. In the evening, a warm and cosy 3*hotel awaits us.

Day-by-day itinerary

DAY 1

Meet at 6pm on Sunday at the hotel in Morzine for a briefing with your tour leader.

DAY 2

COL LA BASSE AND COL RATTI (1905m)

An amazing panorama for the first day hiking overlooking the Mont-Blanc range. A flexible hike with different possibilities to get to know the group.

3 to 4 hour walk / Elevation: between +300 et +550 m / -300 à -650 m / 6 à 9 km

DAY 3

LA CHAILLA RIDGES AND GOLESE PASS

Crossing old pastures, this hike brings us to a ridge (1837m) which offers a "postcard view" all over the Dent Blanche massif and one of the major Geopark spot : the "Rouleau de Bostan". Going back via the Golèse refuge.

4.5 hour walk / Elevation: +/- 600m / 11km

DAY 4

BISE AND DARBON LAKE

Shift of valley to observe ibex between the Bise high limestone cliffs. Picnic at the edge of the emerald Darbon Lake.

5 hour walk / Elevation: +/- 620m / 10km

DAY 5

PASS AND PEAK OF CHALUNE

Departure from the Foron pasture, between chamois and marmots that we can observe in the near distance. Going up to the Chalune pass and on to the summit (2116m) for those who wish. Going back via the Bolire pass though the pastures.

4.5 to 5.5 hour walk / Elevation: between +/- 640m and +/- 760m /10km

DAY 6**COL DE COUX AND FARM VISIT**

Between smuggling and migration, Col de Coux (1920m) is full of stories... without forgetting the view over the Swiss mountains. Going back via the Freterolles farm to visit their cheese production where you can buy some local cheese.

4 hour walk / Elevation: +/- 680 m à +/- 900m / de 7,5km à 10km

DAY 7**End point Saturday morning after breakfast.**

The itinerary is established according to the latest information available, the possibility of unknown factors affecting this itinerary is possible including situations beyond our control which may change the route, timings etc. (depending on the natural conditions and the fitness of the group).

THE PRICE

- PACK MOBILITE EXTRA : daily transfers with the Altitude Mont Blanc bus from the hotel to the hiking departure point. (+ €60 per person).

The price includes:

- Organisation and booking fees, guiding by a qualified mountain leader;
- Hotel accommodation with half-board formula;
- Lunch picnics and snacks during the day;
- Tourist tax;

The price does not include:

- The cancellation insurance;
- Personal expenses (drinks, etc.), touristic visits;
- Transfer from the hotel to the hikes departures.



The price is all inclusive from departure to end point.



The journey

LEVEL ***

Elevation: +/- 400 to 700m approximately per day.

Walking time: 3 to 5 hours per day depending on the group.

Type of trek: this tour is not technically difficult.

According to the group's fitness level, some higher level variations are possible.

The tour with one hotel only allows you to have rest day during the week at any point.

GUIDING

Number in a group between 6 and 14 people guided by a qualified professional mountain leader.

The mountain guide leader may have to modify the programme to adapt it to the level of the participants and/or the natural conditions. As a last resort, he is the sole decision-maker.

To thank your guide, it is usual to tip him at the end of the trek, according to your satisfaction. It is not mandatory but, it is very appreciated.

TRANSFER DURING THE HIKE

The agency offers daily transfers to the hikes by minibus as part of the mobility package (€60 extra). If you do not choose this option, you will need to use your own car for the entire journey.

ACCOMMODATION

6 nights in a 3-star hotel in twin/double bedroom. Single supplement: 160€ for the week (depending on availability).

Located 500m from the centre of Morzine, this hotel offers all the comfort for a week of sports and relaxation: a large living room with warming wood fire, spa with sauna, jacuzzi, indoor heated pool and a cosy bar. The hotel is also a food lovers heaven with a large menu of local dishes.

The village centre is within easy walking distance with a large selection of shops and an outdoor ice-rink. Weekly cultural events include: a visit to the sawmills in Morzine old town, the slatemines or the local cheese makers producing tomme, reblochon and abondance. Morzine also offers a lively après-ski nightlife with wine bars, pubs, open air djs, clubs....

MEALS

Breakfast and dinner are taken at the hotel. For lunch, your guide will prepare picnics, generally with salad and regional products. **Please specify any allergies or dietary requirements when booking**. We do our best to accommodate special diets (gluten-free, vegetarian, etc.). However, we encourage you to bring a few extra products for your own picnics.

Practical information

ACCESS TO DEPARTURE POINT

Meet Sunday at 6pm at the hotel in Morzine.

BY TRAIN

Inbound: depart from Paris Gare de Lyon, to Thonon. Then bus from Thonon to Morzine with [BUS Y91](#). 10 minutes walk (or free village bus) to the hotel.

Return: depart from Morzine by bus to Thonon. Then train from Thonon to Paris Gare de Lyon.

BY CAR

Take the A40 motorway to Cluses, then direction Morzine/Avoriaz (Les Portes du Soleil), follow Taninges and Les Gets.

Equipment and luggage

EQUIPMENT LIST

Clothing

- Walking trousers
- Shorts (Bikini/swimsuit, just in case!)
- Breathable or merino wool t-shirts
- Breathable or merino wool leggings
- Fleece or jumper
- Lightweight down jacket
- Wind stopper or Goretex jacket
- Waterproof poncho + gaiters or Goretex trousers + waterproof rucksack cover
- Pair of gloves and a warm hat
- Sun hat or baseball cap
- Walking socks (1 pair per day)
- Sturdy walking boots with a good sole, already broken in
- 1 change of clothes for the evening
- A pair of comfortable shoes for the evening

Other Equipment

- Toilet bag
- Quick drying towel
- Sunglasses and sun cream
- Water bottle or Camelback (1.5 litre minimum)
- Knife, fork and spoon
- Plastic lunch box/plate for your picnic lunches (0,4 ~ 0,5L)
- Plastic cup for coffee
- Small First Aid kit (antihistamine, ibuprofen, Compeed type blister pads...)
- Survival blanket
- Head torch or hand torch
- Sleeping bag liner sheet and pillowcase (blankets provided at accommodation)
- Two adjustable walking poles (highly recommended)
- Identity card or passport

BACKPACK

Bring a comfortable backpack of 30 to 40 litres for your personal belongings for the day (warm clothes, waterproofs, water, plate and cutlery for your picnic, sunscreen and your identity papers) and please keep a little room to carry a picnic and snacks.
